



2021 BRICOLEUR VINEYARDS KICK RANCH SAUVIGNON BLANC

The 2021 Sauvignon Blanc fruit comes from Bricoleur Vineyards' second estate vineyard – Kick Ranch. Kick Ranch is a stunning hillside vineyard carved into Spring Mountain on the Sonoma/Napa border in the Fountaingrove District AVA. Kick Ranch was established in 2001 and quickly became popular among winemakers for its Bordeaux and Rhone varietals. Its warm summer days and calcareous rocky soils make for perfect growing conditions.

Highly aromatic, the wine kicks off with citrus blossom and fresh cut lime on the nose. Layers of green apples, Oro Blanco grapefruit, lemon verbena interlace with a thread of minerality and lively acidity. Well defined and sophisticated with a lovely mouthfeel and zesty, extended finish.
