



2019 BRICOLEUR VINEYARDS RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY PINOT NOIR

Our 40-acre estate sits in the Russian River Valley AVA in Windsor, CA and is planted to Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. The region's coastal influence creates ideal growing conditions for these Burgundian Varieties with cool summer nights and long, warm days. Our Estate Pinot Noir is a blend of five clones we hand harvest by night and vinify in individual lots. During fermentation we gently punch down the berries twice a day to release varietal flavors and aromas. After primary fermentation is complete, the five lots age sur lie fourteen months in a mix of barrels from our favorite French coopers.

Our 2019 Estate Pinot Noir is as compelling as ever as forest floor and fresh cherries on the nose leaves no doubt that Pinot Noir is in the glass. Layers of mushrooms, tart red cherries, pomegranate seeds, earthy nuances, olive tapenade, and anise unwind in harmony on the palate. The underlying oak is perfectly managed and adds depth. Silky smooth in texture with gentle tannins, and the persistent finish feature exotic spice.
