## ISLA ROSE BRUT ROSÉ

### VINEYARD NOTES

Our release of the Isla Rose Brut Rosé is a blend of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Gris, and Pinot Meunier fruit primarily sourced from the Carneros Region. The cooling marine influence results in grapes with complexity, great acidity, and longer ripening time, ideal for crafting a premium California Brut.

### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Fruit for our Isla Rose Brut Rosé is the first to be harvested each year. The component base wines are fermented at cool temperatures in small stainless-steel tanks to preserve freshness and fruit intensity and then bottled en tirage and aged 18 months. Yeast and sugar are added to the wine to create a second fermentation. While en tirage, the wine develops delicate bubbles and savory tertiary notes desirable from bottle aging. Once aging is complete, the wine is riddled and disgorged.

### TASTING NOTES

Bright aromas of strawberry, watermelon, and cherry blossom erupt from the glass with subtle savory notes of brioche coming through. The palette is bright and balanced as vibrant flavors of raspberry and strawberry are complimented by fine carbonation, toasted baguette, and a lasting finish.

### THE STORY

In celebration of his first granddaughter, co-founder, Mark Hanson wanted to show his love and excitement by planting Isla Rose's roots in Bricoleur Vineyards history by establishing a signature wine in her honor.

This wine embodies the entrepreneurial spirit of strong female leadership and represents the countless empowered women in the wine industry. Bricoleur Vineyards was co-founded by mother and daughter and will continue to inspire generations of future female leaders.
